University organized a rally on **08-12-17** which aimed at spreading awareness about significance of voting. 100 volunteers of the college, with placards in hands, covered most of the main areas of V. V. Nagar. Under signature campaign, they also took signatures from the pedestrians and some local residents of V.V. Nagar.

31. The unit, in association with Diya NGO, V.V. Nagar organized a One-Day Workshop titled 'Build Yourself' on **10-12-17**. This workshop aimed at orienting volunteers about youth empowerment. Resource persons from the NGO delivered conducted sessions on variety of topics. Dr. Gayatriben Patel- a pharmacist from CHARUSAT delivered a talk on 'Keys to Success'. Mr. Jigar Thakkar spoke on the topic 'Importance of Reading'. Renowned ophthalmologist Dr. Alpeshbhai Shah addressed the volunteers on 'Scientific Spirituality'. Mr. Himanshu Vaidhya talked about 'Human Excellence'. The speakers asked questions on their respective topics and also answered questions put forth by the few volunteers. Dr. Bharatbhai Bhatt, Mr. Dharmesh Taretiya and Mr. Ajay Gupta from Diya NGO managed the programme in a commendable manner.
32. The NSS Unit of the college organized ANNUAL NSS CAMP at Naman village (Ta: Borsad and Dist: Anand) from **31.12.17** to **06.01.18** wherein 175 (One Hundred and Seventy-Five) students participated. Many activities related to social service such as Free Medical Check-up Camp, Free Cataract Operation, Rally on AIDS prevention and Street plays on social issues like 'Dowry', 'Domestic Violence', 'Addiction Eradication' etc. were organized in this camp.
33. The NSS unit, in association with Indian Red Cross Society and Lioness Club, Anand organized Thalassaemia Screening Camp on **09-01-18** wherein 409 students of the college got the benefit of the camp.
34. The NSS unit, in association with Indian Red Cross Society and Lioness Club, Anand organized Blood Donation Camp on **10-01-18** wherein 70 students of the college got the benefit of the camp.
35. On the occasion of birth anniversary of Swami Vivekanand, the NSS unit celebrated Youth Day on **12-01-18** wherein Dr. Yogesh Patel, NSS Programme Officer oriented students about the importance of the day. IQAC Coordinator Dr. Rita Kumar addressed students on the values preached by Swamiji. The students listened to the renowned address delivered by Vivekanand at the Chicago conference. 75 students participated in this programme.
36. Mock Parliament was organized by Knowledge Sharing Forum, in association with NSS Unit, on **08-02-18**. The aim behind this programme was to make students aware of a few social issues and reforms such as GST, Demonetization, Freedom of Expression etc. The students came to know about the way Parliament functions. In this mock parliament, organized by students, Hundred students took active participation.

The NSS Unit organized **ANNUAL NSS CAMP** at Naman village (Ta: Borsad and Dist: Anand) from **31.12.17** to **06.01.18** which is nearly 12 kms away from Vallabh Vidyanagar. Total 175 (One Hundred Seventy Five) students participated in this camp. sMentioned below is the detailed record of the activities carried out during this camp.

Day- 1 31.12.2017

- The NSS volunteers, along with three NSS Programme Officers and four faculty members, moved to Naman village at 2.30 pm. Between 4 pm and 6 pm the volunteers visited different parts of the village and invited villagers to attend the inaugural function to be organized at 11 am on the next day. After dinner a meeting was conducted to orient students about the activities to be conducted during the camp. The NSS volunteers were divided into groups and a group leader was selected for each group.

Day- 2 01.01.2018

- A session of Yoga was conducted from 7.30 am to 8 am.
- The Inaugural Function was organized in Naman Primary School at 11 am. The function started with University Song and NSS Song. Prof. S. G. Patel-Hon. Secretary Charutar Vidya Mandal presided over the function. Dr. Gurusevaksing Saggi- NSS Coordinator of S. P. University, V. V. Nagar was

invited as the Chief Guest. Dr. Basudeb Bakshi- Principal of the college, Mr. Ratilal- Sarpanch of the village, Mr. Swapnil Parmar- Principal of Naman Primary School, Mr. Ambalalbai Patel, Mr. Jagdishbhai Patel and many villagers were also present in the function.

- At 3.30 pm a Rally was organized with slogans on the subject 'Addiction Eradication'. The rally passed through almost all the streets of the village. Teachers and students visited the slum area where people seemed to have various addictions. The volunteers explained to people how addictions could be harmful to them. The villagers were also informed about the Free Medical Check-up Camp and Eye Check-up camp to be organized by the NSS unit.
- After dinner a brainstorming session was organized. Also, the volunteers were informed about the planned activities of the next day and assigned various duties.

Day- 3 02.01.2018

- From 7 am to 8 am a session of meditation was conducted.
- A Free Medical Check-up Camp was organized from 10 am to 1 pm. A team of doctors and paramedical staff from Surajben Govindbhai Patel Ayurvedic Hospital, New Vallabh Vidyanagar examined two hundred and twenty-seven villagers and medicines were given free of cost as per requirement. Some teams were assigned the duty to assist the medical staff.
At the same time some volunteers were conducted educational and co-curricular activities in various classes of the Primary School.
- Between 3 pm and 5 pm a team of doctors from Sankra Eye Hospital, Mogar checked 97 patients suffering from symptoms of cataract out of whom 50 patients were asked to report at 9.30 on 03-01-18 for further screening. One team of volunteers managed this primary check-up session. Some volunteers were provided forms for survey on availability of basic facilities to the villagers like clean drinking water, house, toilets, electricity, bank account, ADHAR CARD, etc.
- From 4.30 to 6.30 the volunteers had a Cricket match between senior and junior volunteers.
- After dinner, a programme of Bhavai was organized by the villagers. The aim behind this programme was to make students aware of how this form of folkdance, which is on the verge of extinction at present, was used for entertainment in the folk-culture.

Day- 4 03.01.2018

- From 7 am to 8 am a session of meditation was conducted.
- Between 9 am and 1 pm a team of doctors from Sankra Eye Hospital, Mogar made thorough screening of the suspected patients. At last 22 patients were taken to Sankra Eye Hospital for operation of cataract. One group of students helped the medical team throughout the screening session.
- Between 10 am and 1 pm, some volunteers performed street plays on the topics 'Dowry' and 'Domestic Violence'. Some volunteers played cricket match from 3 pm to 5 pm. Simultaneously, 'Mahendi Making Competition' was organized for the girls and women of the village from 3 pm to 4.30 pm. Winners were given Prizes on the spot.
- After dinner, a programme of Bhajan was organized in association with Shri Krishna Bhajan Mandal, Mogri from 9 pm to 11.30 pm.

Day- 5 04.01.2018

- A session of Yoga was conducted from 7.30 am to 8 am.
- A guest lecture was organized between 8.30 am and 10.30 am wherein Ms. Tamanna Upadhyay – the alumna of the college oriented volunteers about preparation of GPSC exam.
- From 10.30 am to 12.30 pm a session was organized wherein all the groups were assigned some tasks involving brainstorming exercises. Volunteer sread report of activities organized till that day. Students found those exercises very interesting and helpful in analyzing their perspective towards life.

- From 2.15 to 3.15 the volunteers visited a S. D. Patel Fulbai Vidyamandir, Pamol where the volunteers conducted variety of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities in ten classes of Std. 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th.
- Between 3.30 pm and 5.30 pm, the volunteers had cricket match with the boys of Pamol village.
- After dinner, programme of traditional Garba was organized. Village folk also accompanied NSS volunteers and enjoyed the Garba from 9 pm to 11.30 pm.

Day- 6 05.01.2018

- A session of Yoga was conducted from 7.30 am to 8 am.
- Dr. Dhvani Sharma- a motivational speaker addressed the volunteers on various topics such 'Role of NSS in Development of the Nation', 'Personality Development', 'Self-discipline', 'Goal-Setting' and various government schemes for youth from 10 am to 11.15 am.
- Between 9 am and 1.30 pm a cattle camp was organized in association with Anand Veterinary College, Anand. 45 animals suffering from sterility were successfully treated in this camp.
- From 11.30 am to 12.30 pm a session was organized wherein two IT experts from ITC, Mogri oriented students on 'Microsoft Office 365' with the help of PPT. The students asked many questions related to the topic.
- From 2 pm to 5 pm the volunteers stayed in homes of some villagers. In this novel activity, the students talked to villagers about their life-style and village culture. This gave them an opportunity to come in close contact with the villagers and observe the village life very closely.
- After dinner, cultural programme was organized wherein some volunteers as well as village children performed dance and singing.

Day- 7 06.01.2018

- ➤ The valedictory function of NSS camp started at 10.30 am in the premises of Naman Primary School. Mr. Kartik Jagtap presented the report of activities organized during the camp. The Principal, Vice President of Madhyastha Samiti, various Heads of Departments and village people remained present. Dr. Yogesh Patel proposing the vote of thanks, sincerely thanked all the Principals and teachers of the village schools as well as villagers for all their generous support and cooperation. He also thanked Principal and college faculty members and supporting staff of the college to provide all necessary help and support in successfully carrying out the camp activities.
